MD NHM made a presentation on the emergence of a variant of concern B1.1.529 (Omicron) in India and the latest instructions from Government of India (PPT at Annexure I). After detailed discussion, the following decisions were taken:

- 1. Health & Family Welfare Department will issue a consolidated notification for the Standard Operating Protocol to be followed up for screening International Travellers coming to Assam directly or indirectly and the tracing of their contacts, as discussed and approved in the meeting.
- 2. Considering the possibility of sudden increase in cases, immediate steps to assess and improve existing Infrastructure, HR, Medicines, Oxygen Supply, testing and

screening facilities etc will be taken up with strict time lines under concerned Nodal Officers as follows:

- Commissioner & Secretary PWD (Building) and Chief Engineer PWD (B) dedicated for Health & Family Welfare Department shall be responsible for completion of PICU/ICU works in Medical Colleges & District Hospitals at the earliest.
- 6. Review meeting on control and prevention of COVID Variant shall be taken up in accordance with the national and international developments and fresh guidelines.
