OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Re-imbursement of Expenses of Medical Treatment incurred by Officers/ Employees of Regular Govt. Establishments.

It is observed that Administrative Departments very often seek approval/views/admissibility report etc from the Health and Family Welfare Department in respect of medical reimbursement claims, though in most of the cases the Administrative Department is competent to examine the cases under the provisions of the Assam Medical Attendance Rules 2008 read with the Assam Medical Attendance (amendment) Rules, 2012 and issue sanction for medical reimbursement under the provisions of Delegation of Financial Power Rules, 1999.

It is clearly mentioned in the aforesaid rules that only in respect of the cases involving surgical operations and supply of artificial appliance, approval of Health and Family Welfare Department is required.

Though in respect of some of the cases which come under the purview of rule 6(C) of AMA Rule, 2008 views of the Health and Family Welfare Department may be sought, the rule does not bind this department to convey approval for all such claims. In respect of such claims the date line mentioned in that rule should be maintained otherwise Health and Family Welfare Department will not consider such cases which is received after the stipulated date line unless sufficient and justified grounds are properly explained.

In order to enable speedy disposal of medical reimbursement claims and to avoid unnecessary reference of such claims to the Health and Family Welfare Department, the following guidelines which are already in vogue are reiterated once again and it is impressed upon all the Administrative Departments to strictly follow them and not to refer any case to this Department except the cases which only require the approval of the Health & FW Department.

- 1. The Administrative Department should thoroughly examine a case under the provisions of AMA Rules, 2008 and guidelines issued from time to time and issue sanction under the provision of DFP rules, 1999.
 - 2. When all the conditions of AMA rules are fulfilled but there is involvement of surgical operation or supply of artificial appliance then only such cases should be referred to this department for approval. In doing so, it must be clearly indicated as to why the case is referred to the Health & Filmily Welfare Department.
 - 3. There are a number of referral hospitals approved by the Health and Family welfare Department and the ailments for which they are referral hospitals are clearly mentioned against each of the hospitals. Moreover, such hospitals are referral hospitals only from the date of issue of notification by this department. A list containing all the referral hospitals and ailments for which they are referral hospitals and date from which they are referral is enclosed for ready reference. For easy disposal of cases a check list is appended herewith. The check list should be authenticated by the officer from whose end the proposal comes.
 - 4. Administrative Department will not refer any case for ex-post-facto approval of Referral Board or ex-post-facto approval of the Director of Health Services or

Admissibility report and cases involving treatment in a hospital which is not a referra

- 5. The Referral Medical Board will not refer a case to----
 - (a) a hospital which is not declared by the Govt. as referral hospital,
 - (b) a hospital which is declared by the Govt. as referral hospital but not for the ailment intended to be treated.

This is applicable in respect of ex-post-facto approval also accorded by the Referral Medical Board. All the Referral Medical Boards will check the list of Referral Hospitals appended herewith before approval/ ex-post-facto approval is given by them.

6. Cost of treatment of family members, of a retired Govt. Servant is not reimbursable except only for husband & wife.

A claim for medical reimbursement should conform to all the conditions of AMA Rules 2008 and the conditions laid down in the notifications issued from time to time by the Health and Family Welfare Department.

A copy of the Assam Medical Attendance Rules, 2008 and after relevant papers are enclosed herewith.

Procedure for sanction/ drawal of Medical

Re-imbursement Bill.

- 1. The Power to sanction Medical Re-imbursement claim of State Government employees/ Pensioners has been delegated to the Administrative Departments. Administrative Departments sanction the same as per provisions of Assam Medical Attendance Rule 1976 as amended and instructions issued there under from time to time, on receipt of such claim directly and also from other Controlling Officers/ Drawing and Disbursing Officers (D.D.O.) under them. Procedures for submission Medical Re-imbursement bill by the Pensioners to the concerned Administrative Departments will continue to be followed by Finance Department's letter No.BB.89/95/33 dated 4.8.1997.
- 2. The Controlling Officers / D.D.O. while submitting such proposal for Medical re-imbursement to respective Administrative Department will furnish the following documents/ information after being satisfied about the genuineness of the claim:-
 - (i) Authorised Medical Attendant's recommendation,
 - (ii) Recommendation of the Referral Medical Board, wherever applicable,
 - (iii) The approval of the Director of Health Services, Assam, wherever applicable,
 - (iv) Essentiality Certificate to be issued by Authorised Medical Attendant,
 - (v) Records of the Referral Hospital/ Government Hospital/ Private Hospital,
 - (vi) Final Bill issued by the hospital authority at the time of discharge,
 - (vii) Discharge Certificate from the Hospital concerned,
 - (viii) Budget allocation,
 - (ix) Bank Account Number of the claimant.
- Administrative Department after being satisfied about the genuineness of the claim, shall sanction the same after observing all necessary formalities and issue an Advice Slip duly filled in with signature and seal along with the copy of sanction meant for the Treasury Officer to the concerned Treasury Officer directly in a sealed cover. Advice Slip will be supplied by Finance (Budget) Department to each Administrative Department. Accordingly, all Administrative Departments are to submit their demand to Finance (Budget) Department for supply of required number of Advice Slip.

- The Treasury Officer will keep the Advice Slip with him until he receives Medical Reimbursement Bills from the D.D.O. concerned. The Treasury Officer will verify the genuineness of the signature of the signing authority as appearing in the sanctioning order, Advice Slip and the sanctioning letter attached with the Medical Reimbursement Bill by comparing them with the specimen signature of the signing authority available with him. In case of any doubt, the Treasury Officer may request the Administrative Department for further information, which may also require verification of the claim with the concerned hospital, if considered necessary. The Treasury Officer shall pass the bill for payment only through Bank Account of the claimant, after he satisfies himself about the genuineness of the bill as above.
- 5. Since all medical re-imbursement bills are drawn by the concerned D.D.O.s, it is primary responsibility of the D.D.O.s to be satisfied about the genuineness of the claims before submission of the medical re-imbursement bills to the Treasury for payment.
- 6. For any financial loss caused to the State Government due to fraudulent drawal of Medical Re-imbursement Bills, the concerned D.D.O. alongwith the claimant and other guilty of abetment will be penalized under relevant provisions of the Assam Fiscal Responsibility & Budget Management Act (AFRBM Act), 2005 and that of the Indian Penal Code.

The instruction will be effective for all Medical Reimbursement bills 7. submitted/ to be submitted during the current financial year (2007-08) onwards.
